Two Becky Allen Fund recipients receive parent education grants for their co-ops

This year's Becky Allen Fund recipients were Northeast Cooperative Preschool and Speedway Cooperative Preschool both in Indianapolis, IN.

Northeast Cooperative held "Literacy Night". The program involved both parents and children. Parents learned about emergent literacy and how to foster children's literacy development. Both children and parents were given the opportunity to explore fun, hands-on literacy activities such as writing in sand trays, playdough letters and book making. Each family received a Literacy bag containing materials and resources to help promote literacy at home.



Speedway's parent and teacher education program was entitled "Raising a Confident Child". Cynthia Love, a nurse and paediatric health professional, talked about how to encourage children's feelings of self-worth and the importance of limits and consistent guidance to help children feel secure.

A Founder of Parent Cooperative Preschools International

Jean Harris Stevenson Passed away peacefully on March 8, 2010 at the age of 89, born and raised in London, Ontario, Jean, a gifted athlete and scholar, graduated from U. of T. (B.A., B. Ed. Victoria College, 1943). Throughout her life, Jean was dedicated to the service and needs of preschool children. During her career, Jean taught secondary school, was Coordinator of the ECE Program at Georgian College and supervisor in the Day Nurseries Branch of Community and Social Services. She was actively involved with PCPI since its' inception in 1960, helped found the organization, and was President in the early years. Jean leaves behind a legacy through her many contributions professionally, as a volunteer and through her love of children, family and friends.

A prolific writer, Jean leaves behind a library of academic papers and newsletter articles, and will be featured in the fall issue of Cooperatively Speaking.
