MARIKA TOWNSHEND TRAVEL GRANT APPLICATION

To help our members participate in PCPI by coming to the annual meeting, PCPI established and now honors a longtime cooperative preschool advocate with the Marika Townshend Travel Grant program. *The 2022 annual meeting will be held in Portland, Oregon April 28 - May 1, 2022.* Please consider attending the PCPI working meetings to network and learn with like-minded co-op people and to exercise your membership vote.

Grant applications must be received on or before **February 15, 2022.**

ELIGIBILITY AND CRITERIA

All PCPI members - individuals, schools, councils - are eligible for a travel grant to attend the PCPI Annual Meeting. Schools/councils may sponsor teachers, staff, board members or other members.

Applicants must have an interest in PCPI activities and a desire to gain new knowledge and experiences to benefit cooperative preschools.

Funds will be used to cover costs to attend the PCPI annual meeting (registration, lodging, travel expenses). Grant recipients will be reimbursed in US dollars after the meeting upon submitting expense receipts.

PCPI has limited budgeted funds available for the 2022 Marika Townshend Travel Grants as well as funds donated in Marika's memory. The number of grants and amounts for each will vary depending upon need and the fund balance.

Grant recipients are expected to attend the entire meeting. While the schedule is not yet complete, attendees should expect to arrive on Thursday evening, April 28 and adjourn by Sunday noon, May 1*. This includes 10-12 hours of meetings plus the Awards event and school visits.

The application **must** include the amount you or your school/council can pay. This amount is subtracted first from expenses. **Using US dollars**, research your total expected costs, subtract what you can pay, and then you can request the remainder as a grant. For example, if you can pay \$300 and total expected expenses are \$1,000, apply for up to



\$700. If your total actual expenses are \$900, \$300 is subtracted and you will be reimbursed \$600. However, if total expenses are \$1200, \$300 is subtracted and the grant pays \$700; you are responsible for the additional \$200.

To apply for a 2022 MARIKA TOWNSHEND TRAVEL GRANT, complete the application information on the next page. Email that information along with a letter of recommendation from your school, council or a fellow PCPI member to travelgrants@preschools.coop.

Additional information about the 2022 PCPI Annual Meeting and Awards will be posted as it becomes available - visit the PCPI website at www.preschools.coop and watch for group emails.

Application deadline is February 15, 2022.

Application must be SUBMITTED by deadline in order to be considered.

Receipt of application materials will be acknowledged. Applications will be promptly reviewed by the Marika Townshend Travel Grants Committee and awardees notified quickly in order to facilitate travel planning.

* Availability of airline flights will be taken into consideration.
